What is this Grant For?

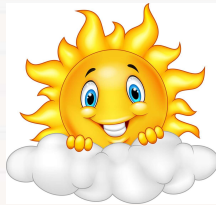
This grant (and Johnstonville's plan) is designed to provide supplemental instruction and support to students:

1. Academic Needs.
2. Social-Emotional Needs.
3. Other Needs Including Meals and Snacks.
4. Focus On Student Groups Of Low-Income, English Learners, Foster Youth, Homeless, Students with Disabilities, Students at Risk of Abuse/Neglect/Exploitation, Disengaged Students, and Students who are Below Grade Level.
5. The recovery plan will include:
 - Extended Learning Time.
 - Integrated student supports to address othr barriers to learning.
 - Community learning hubs that provide students with access to technology, high-speed internet, and other academic supports.
 - Additional academic services for students.
 - Training for school staf on strategies to engage students and families in addressing students' social-emotional health and academic needs.

Extending Instructional Learning Time

Summer Academy = \$27,853 (26%)

- 2 Certificated Teachers
- 2 Instructional Aides
- 1 Cook
- 1 Custodian
- Food
- Instructional Supplies



After-School Program = \$40,559 (38%)

- 2 Classified Staff
- Food
