Hello Johnstonville Families:

Please take a few moments every day to conduct a quick wellness check of your children before they come to school. Please keep your student home if they have any of the following symptoms or exposures. If your student has any of these symptoms when they arrive at school, or develop them during the school day, you will be contacted to pick your student up from school immediately and Lassen County Public Health will also be notified per state mandate.

SECTION 1: SYMPTOMS

If your child has any of the following symptoms, that indicates a possible illness that may decrease the student’s ability to learn and also put them at risk for spreading illness to others. Please check your child for these symptoms:

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| | Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth |
| | Sore throat |
| | New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/ asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline) |
| | Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain |
| | New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever |

SECTION 2: CLOSE CONTACT/POTENTIAL EXPOSURE

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| | Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19 |
| | Traveled to or lived in an area where the local, Tribal, territorial, or state health department is reporting large numbers of COVID-19 cases as described in the Community Mitigation Framework |
| | Live in areas of high community transmission (as described in the Community Mitigation Framework) while the school remains open |



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
