

7.1.2	SUPERINTENDENT REPORT	<p>Dr. Scott Smith reported:</p> <p>Bob McGarva at Lassen County is researching the encroachment permits for the 25 mph radar signs and CHP has increased their patrol in the area.</p> <p>Pros and Cons of combining Johnstonville Elementary School District with Shaffer School District:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LCFF has changed the calculations since last study on combining districts • Patty Gunderson provided information on funding stating that the combination of the districts would only increase revenue from the state by \$1,000. • It would cost Johnstonville Elementary School \$66,000 for the implementation of combining schools • Potential savings in 3 years we are required to maintain non-certified positions for 2 years • We would need to implement transportation <p>Assembly Bill (AB)/Senate Bill (SB) No. 86</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funds of \$50,000 will be awarded if we continue to be open until April 1, 2021 • Funds of \$100,000 to help mitigate learning loss • Prop 98 funds are utilized to fund AB/SB 86 • Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) will be the tool for calculating the districts revenues.
